

Project Title: Bridging the Digital Divide - Cyber Security for the Elderly

International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS) is conducting a project to equip the elderly people in our communities with protective measures against cyber security threats through educational and practical workshops and online resources as part of its 'CyberSafe Seniors Program'.

This project is being funded by a Cyber Security Awareness Support for Vulnerable Groups Grant by the Department of Home Affairs of the Australian Government

The program has a free online self-paced short course for continued learning and support for the participants.

The project is looking for participants who meet the following criteria:

- At or above the age of **65**
- Not highly dependent on medical care
- Do not have a cognitive impairment, an intellectual disability or mental illness
- Reside within the Northern Beaches region of Sydney, New South Wales

Participants will be asked to complete the following activities if they agree to participate:

- **Participate in a workshop:** Register to participate in a 45-minute face-to-face workshop. The workshop will be facilitated by one of the trained project team members. One of the locations of the workshops is at ICMS Northern Beaches Campus, 151 Darley Road, Manly NSW 2095. As more host partner locations become available these will be listed on the program's registration page.
- **Pre- and post-surveys:** Complete an online or paper survey soon before and after the workshop. Each survey should take approximately 10 minutes to complete.
